The Huang Scholarship consists of 6 months in Taiwan and 1.5 years abroad in the United States (e.g., Stanford Unversity, Duke University).

Physicians who have graduated from a Taiwan medical school can apply for this opportunity.

- **MS Degree**: Each track can earn a master's in the US.

 Clinical training + MA in Bioethics & Science Policy from Duke University
 - Health Policy Track (available 2024-2025):
 MS in Health Policy from Stanford University
 - Clinical Research Track (available 2024-2025):
 MS in Epidemiology and Clinical Research from Stanford University
- Financial Support: Tuition and a living stipend are provided based on need and where not already covered by financial aid.
- Mentorship: Each scholar is paired with a mentor who provides personal, academic, and professional guidance, as well as specialized career services for internships and jobs.
- Career Acceleration: Access to a wide healthcare network in the US and Taiwan. Scholars will go through an emerging leaders training program.

This program facilitates connections and collaborations between the healthcare systems of Taiwan and the US. It is the singular leadership training program for Taiwan-trained physicians that offers a global perspective to benefit Taiwan. Each scholar has a pathway to earn a degree, invaluable experience, and establish lifelong networks from a top US university.

2. Why recruit people <35?

Our New School program already offers an EMBA with NCCU for those over 35. The Huang Scholarship seeks to develop early career professionals with leadership potential in healthcare, providing them with the necessary skills and connections to create a meaningful impact in the field.

3. How much is the program?

The application is free, and financial aid is provided to eligible scholars based on need. The program aims to enable scholars to pursue graduate-level educational opportunities without financial burden.
